Neville Munns Memorial Scholarships

Annual \$500 Scholarships provided by the WA Shearing Industry Association Inc (WASIA) to WA College of Agriculture students since November 2002.

Eligibility is determined by each College, to be awarded to a deserving year 11 or Year 12 student in the memory of Neville Munns.

Background

- Neville Munns was former CEO of the Pastoralist and Graziers Assoc; EO of WA Farmers Federation; Accountant and EO of the WA Shearing Contractors Association (WASCA), now WASIA.
- Neville is remembered for his commitment to the shearing industry and agriculture, but particularly, as the driving force behind the formation and development of the Western Australian Shearing Contractors Association (now the WA Shearing Industry Association Inc).

Student Selection Process and Criteria for Awarding the Scholarship

- The Agricultural College determines the deserving nominee and makes the selection.
- Student has shown outstanding aptitude and ability in Shearing or Wool Handling.
- Student is interested in a pursuing a career in sheep and wool industry.

Announcement

- Colleges nominating a student are to forward a tax-free invoice to WASIA with the student's name and contact details each year in Sept or Oct. Send to admin@wasia.com.au or to address listed below.
- Any announcements must acknowledge WASIA as the source of the scholarship.
- A representative from the WASIA Executive Committee will attend the graduation ceremony to present the award and will be provided a time to make a short speech.

Conditions/Stipulations

- The Scholarships are to be used for course fees for Shearing and/or Wool Handling training courses or for the recipient to purchase Shearing or Wool Handling equipment.
- Presentation is to include a certificate (available in electronic format, filename: "Neville Munns Certificate.doc"), including the following information:
 - Neville Munns Memorial Scholarship
 - Provided by the Western Australian Shearing Industry Association and Logo;
- A WASIA representative, if available, will attend the presentation ceremony to make a short speech and present the award. WASIA will advise the name of the representative.
