To be eligible, applicants must be a current Year 11 student who is intending to enrol in the Year 12 Trades course.

The value of the scholarship is \$500. This amount will provide financial assistance for trades studies and is to be used as a part payment for Year 12 college costs. It will be paid directly to the college on the student's behalf.

CRITERIA AND SELECTION PROCESS

Applicants will be required to submit a written application (of about 300 - 500 words) with a cover letter attached. There are three selection criteria as below;

The student:

- 1. Demonstrates a positive attitude and a keen work ethic in the College's trade's area.
- 2. Achieves a high standard of performance across both the theoretical and practical components of the trades courses studied at the College.
- 3. Shows commitment to the trade industry (e.g. past and present involvement and future ambitions).

A selection of other supportive documents can be included, such as recent College reports, references, certificates, photographs and details of involvement in other trade related activities.

The successful applicants will be announced at the 2022 College Graduation Ceremony in November.

Closing date for applications is by 4pm on Friday 27 October, 2023
